KoalaPlay Group Develops Two Cutting-Edge Attractions for Six Flags Theme Parks in New Jersey and Illinois

Denver, Colo. (Nov. 18, 2004) – Families looking for incredible adventures not too far from home will find two new attractions to visit next year. KoalaPlay Group, the commercial design and development division of Koala Corp., has partnered with Six Flags, Inc. to develop magnificent new theme and water park attractions.

At Six Flags Great Adventure in Jackson, N.J., KoalaPlay Group is originating a massive play area that incorporates both dry and water play structures into the theme park's new mythical jungle kingdom, for the ultimate family recreational experience. And in Gurnee, Ill., KoalaPlay Group is inventing the world's largest interactive water play attraction for the new Six Flags Hurricane Harbor water park.

"Six Flags has allowed us to stretch our creative muscles and invent two spectacular new attractions that embody the quality, innovation and value that we are known for," said Steve Wagner, vice president of sales and marketing at KoalaPlay Group. "Both play areas deliver endless possibilities for theming, interactivity, and family exploration."

KoalaPlay Group's innovative design for Six Flags Great Adventure's new Balin's Jungleland play area introduces the trend of adding water play structures into a dry theme park. Balin's Jungleland will feature five interactive, multilevel play structures that include two water and three dry play structures and a Superior Foam™ children's play area. The southeastern Asia theme with elephants, tigers, and crawling vines is carried throughout the play land.

"As one of the largest play structures of its kind in the world, we are confident that Balin's Jungleland will become a must-do for families who visit the park," said Rick McCurley, vice president and general manager at Six Flags Great Adventure.

Tower's "A," "B," and "C" are classic dry play structures that have been modified with multiple levels, SkyTwist™ slides, themed elephant and tiger slides, telescopes, bongos, twist n' tangles, punching bags and web crawls. A series of transfer bridges connects the structures for hours of hands-on exploration of the new territories.

Tower's "D" and "E" are two-story WaterColors™ structures joined together with stairways and bridges. The interactive water play areas have buckets, spray jets, water wheels, water blasters and jumping fountains to help guest cool off.

The Superior Foam™ play area is adjacent to tower A and features an elephant and tree slide, tiger and tiger cub climbables and crocodile play pieces underneath a themed awning.

Balin's Jungleland is part of Six Flags Great Adventure's overall expansion named The Golden Kingdom which includes the addition of Kingda Ka – the tallest, fastest roller coaster on Earth; the Temple of the Tiger educational tiger exhibit and new shops and eateries.

At Six Flags Hurricane Harbor, KoalaPlay Group's world-renowned theming experts developed the new water park's anchor attraction, Skull Island. KoalaPlay Group customized its WaterColors™ and Discovery Treehouse™ products and blended them together using transfer platforms and bridges to create the signature attraction.

"KoalaPlay Group has designed a truly one-of-a-kind structure. When it is completed, it will be the most breathtaking water park attraction in the world," said Ron Severt, vice president and general manager of Six Flags Great America and Six Flags Hurricane Harbor. "There is no doubt this play area will quickly become the most popular attraction in the water park."

The interactive water play structure spans nearly 100,000 square feet. Visible from all over the park is a 66-foot high, larger-than-life skull tipping bucket that towers over the entire play structure and drenches guests below with thousands of gallons of water every few minutes.

Visitors will find it impossible to stay dry as two shipwrecked boats spill 750 gallons of water each on unsuspecting guests and a 50-foot high volcano erupts with a geyser of water. Hundreds of fountains, sprayers, water wheels and other interactive water elements are also scattered throughout the enormous water play area.

KoalaPlay Group partnered with ProSlide to intertwine eight slides, ranging from six-feet to 42-feet in height, throughout the structure. A series of transfer bridges, cargo net climbs, and swinging bridges will be used to link 17 distinctive elevated platforms.

Skull Island will connect to an activities area geared toward smaller guests and is close to Six Flags Hurricane Harbor's other key attractions -- an adventure river, wave pool, assortment of water slides and beach areas.
